
House Districts Volumes






Proposal

- Top Two advance to General Election
- Alaska, California, Nebraska, Washington
- Constitutionality: Washington State Grange v
 Washington State Republican Party
 - 7 2 Decision affirming

Schedule

- No change to existing schedule
 - File end of May
 - Primary mid August
 - General November
 - Campaign Season: May Nov
- No change in cost of elections at County


Proposal








